

Self-reporting:

The major BC universities (SFU, UBC and UVic) have self-reporting of grades between January and April, and so do U of A, McGill, and Western.

Ryerson and U of T both require self-reporting as well (but they also require transcripts with Term 1 grades to be uploaded to their portals, which I will talk about more below).

Guidelines for self-reporting:

1) SFU: Jan. 2nd to April 30th (Deadline is Feb 15th for the Major Entrance scholarship applicants and Feb 28th for the Beedie School of Business.)

SFU does want students to report Term 1 marks, and also Term 2 marks if they haven't received an offer by March.

2) McGill: Jan 6th to Feb 1st (early self-reporting)

March 1st to May 1st (regular self-reporting)

4) U of T: self-reporting available through the Join portal.

6) U of A: self-reporting is available right after application, but they want students to wait til 50% of the course is completed before submitting Grade 12 grades. You can go onto the website and update your self-reported grades on a continuous basis.

7) UVic: Feb 15th- March 31st

8) UBC: usually opens in March (they only want Term 2 grades to be self-reported, not Term 1 grades).

Transcripts:

Sending transcripts (with your Term 1 grades) is needed for **some Ontario universities and U of C**. If the university/college wants you to send an unofficial transcript with your Term 1 marks to support your application, the transcript usually has to be sent anytime between January-April and the deadline will vary for each school. **Each university also wants these transcripts to be sent in a different way (uploaded, emailed by the school, etc.) I would recommend sending transcripts in January if you have already applied, or right after you apply. See below for guidelines on how to send them.**

This is different from doing your post secondary selections through STS. Those transcripts don't get sent out til May, and the universities usually want some grade information earlier than that to make their decisions.

These transcripts will be unofficial transcripts (the black and white version that says SDSS at the top). They should have your Grade 11 final grades and your Grade 12 Term 1 marks and it is best for them to be signed. I have access to these transcripts and what I have been doing is signing them and then sending it back to the student, or sending it to the university myself depending what the guidelines are. I believe there is also a copy of this transcript on Student Connect (or one that is very similar).

As far as I know, the Student Transcripts Service does not have transcripts with Term 1 grades for students to send, but will let you know if that changes.

So if you need me to sign a transcript for you or send a transcript, come and see me or send me an email!

Guidelines for transcripts (send in January or right after you apply):

U of T: students need to upload a copy of their transcript to the U of T portal (Join). Deadlines range from Jan. 19th-Feb. 1st. **You also need to self-report your grades in the Join portal.**

Queens: Transcripts need to be sent by the school by email or mail.

Guelph: Transcripts need to be sent by the school by email or mail.

University of Ottawa: A hard copy of your transcript needs to be sent by mail by the school.

York: students need to upload a copy of their transcript to the York portal (MyFile).

Ryerson: students need to upload a copy of their transcript to the Choose Ryerson portal. **Self-reporting of grades is also required.**

U of C: Transcripts need to be sent by the school before Jan 15th for early admission, and before March 15th for regular admission. Please send me your UCID so I can do this for you.
